

Easy ways to share Clayfolk show info

#1 = Share the Clayfolk Show info on your personal social media channels

Go to <http://www.clayfolk.org/clayfolk/>

At both the top of the event webpage and to the far left you will see the Facebook icon (see orange arrows below). Click on either icon and a screen will pop up asking you if you want to post this info on your Facebook page. Just add a little something to personalize your post and then push the blue POST TO FACEBOOK button. *It's that easy!*

NOTE: You can also click on the envelope or plus (+) sign on the far left for other ways to email or post via MANY other forms of social media!
