

## Studio Workshop Supply List

- a stiff brush, smallish for spreading slip
  - cutting wire
  - fettling knife, x-acto knife or something fine to cut with
  - needle tool
  - Notebook
  - scissors
  - card stock or old file folders or thicker paper to make templates with
  - a fat throwing stick, or a big spoon – something curved and smooth for pushing out the insides of things
  - rolling pin &/or Chinese clay mallet
  - any cool texture tools you've got!
  - a box with some soft packing material to take your greenware home in
  - a clean towel or rag
  - pottery sponge
  - ribs for smoothing slabs, including the thin metal scraper rib
